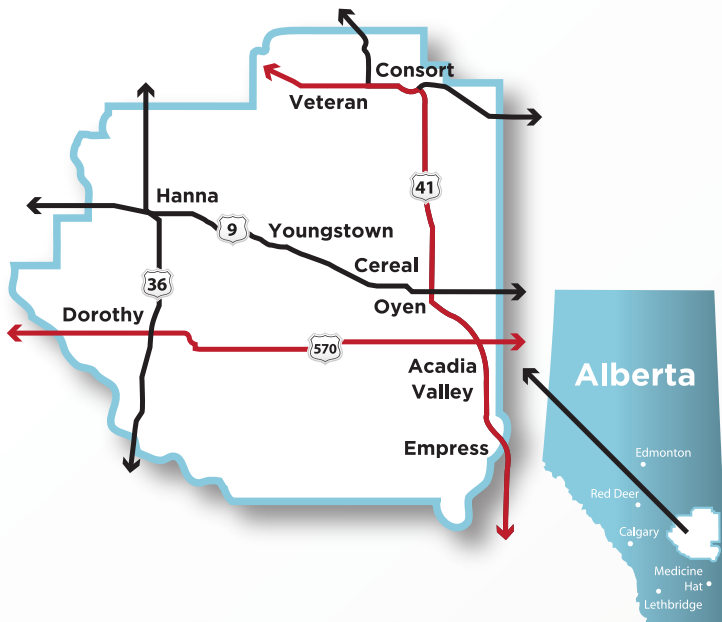


PHOTO INSPIRATION
